

You will be pleased to know that this year; the Society has chosen the Department of Botany and School of Life Sciences, North-Eastern Hill University, Shillong (Meghalaya) to hold its XLVIII All India Botanical Conference. The conference shall be held during October 29-31, 2025 under the Presidentship of Prof. Saroj K. Barik. With great pleasure we invite all IBS members to attend the conference and participate in the scientific sessions, symposia, poster presentations, and other activities of the conference for exchange of thoughts / opinion and scientific interaction.

VENUE

Shillong

Shillong, the capital city of Meghalaya is just 65 km away from Mawsynram, the wettest place on the earth. It is one of the important tourist destinations in the northeast India. It is often referred to as the 'Scotland of the East' due to its striking similarity with the Scotlish Highlands. The city derives its name from Leishylong – the superpower or God who is believed to reside on the Shillong Peak, overlooking the city, Lying in the cared of tall pine trees, Shillong's undulating terrain is a constant source of attraction for tourists both from the country and abroad. The climate is moderately warm and humid during summer but quite cold in winters. October-November and March-April are the best months to visit Shillong. The end October in Shillong will have temperatures ranging from 15-9°C to 22.6°C (80.6°F to 72.7°F). The weather during this time sanging from 15-9°C to 22.6°C (80.6°F to 72.7°F). SCIENTIFIC PROGRAMME

Three-day conference, besides the Presidential Address and Felicitation of distinguished senior botanists for their dedicated life-time services to Plant Sciences, will have four Commemoration Medal Award lectures, two Memorial Award lectures, two Memorial Medals, and two award contest sessions, and eight concurrent sessions for presentation of original research papers and posters in different sections.

The society has instituted four **Commemorative Medals** in honor of well-known Botanists of the Country, namely **Prof. Birbal Sahni, Prof. P. Maheshwari, Prof. V. Puri** and **Prof. Y.S. Murty**. The first three medals are open, and Prof Y.S. Murty Medal is restricted to the Members below the age of 40 years as on 31st December of the year. The society also awards **Life Time Achievement Award** to a distinguished senior botanist for life time services to the Society and botanical sciences.

All the above are based on nomination by the Executive Councilors, and the Medal Awardees of the last 5 years

In addition, there shall be two **Memorial Lecture Awards**. This year these lectures shall be delivered in honor of **Prof. Arun Kumar Sharma**, and **Prof. Laxman Balwant Kajale**.

The Society has also instituted two **Memorial Lecture Medals** in honor of: (i) **Prof. S.N. Chaturvedi** (instituted in 2018), and (ii) **Prof R. S. Tripathi** (instituted in 2025). The respective awardee shall deliver the Lecture at the place of his / her choice, and shall be felicitated at the venue of the AIBC.

The abovementioned Memorial Lecture Awards/Medals are based on nomination by the Executive Councilors.

Awards by Nomination / Application

Prof HY Mohan Ram Award for Excellence in Teaching and Advancement of Plant Sciences: Instituted in 2019, this Medal is awarded to a distinguished botanist. Nominations can be made by the Fellows of the Indian Botanical Society, Fellows of either of the three national science academies, and the students of the nominee. Nomination proforma is available at the Society's website <www.indianbotsoc.org>. The last date for submission of nomination is 30th June 2025.

Prof P.C. Trivedi Medal for Editorial Excellence: Instituted in 2019, this Medal is awarded to an Author / Editor in the field of plant sciences for notable editorial services in the preceding five years. Application proforma is available at the Society's website <www.indianbotsoc.org>. The last date for submission of application is 30th June 2025.

ORAL PRESENTATION IN DIFFERENT SECTIONS

Concurrent sessions shall be arranged for oral presentation of research work in 08 different sections of botanical sciences. Members intending to participate should send a soft copy of full manuscript along with the illustrations and an abstract (**limited to 100**

words). The abstract be prepared in MS word in "Times New Roman" 12 font. and 1.5 spacing, mentioning the Scientific section". The soft copy" should be sent by e-mail to the Organizing Secretary, 48" AIBC, Organizing Secretary, Prof. Suman Kumania, at air-stabliong52@gmail.com, with a copy to Prof. Seshu Lavania, Secretary IBS, at secretary-ibs2017@gmail.com, by 31st July, 2025. No member is allowed to submit more than two submissions, including as co-author. The papers received after 31st July, 2025, and the abstracts not accompanied by full papers, or the papers sent by non-members or by those who have not paid membership dues for 2025 will not be entertained. All the authors must be the member of the Society. The abstract, if accepted after scrutiny, will be published in the book of abstracts of the All India Bolanical Conference.

Certificate of Merit / Medal in different sections

Further, in order to encourage young botanists below the age of 30 years** as on 31st December, 2025, the society awards 'Certificate of Merit' and medals instituted in honour of Senior Botanists (Prof. Jafar Nizam, Prof. Y.D. Tyagi, Prof. L.P. Mail, Prof. O.P. Mail, Prof. C.P. Mail, Prof. C.P. Mail, Prof. O.P. Mail

proof of age. The cut-off date for the age limit is December 31st,2025. Where there are more than one award is available in one age group category, then the contestant is allowed to avail only one award. Applications for these awards should be submitted on the prescribed proforma failing which the application will not be entertained.

YOUNG BOTANIST AWARD CONTEST: A separate section will be held for young botanists below the age of 35 years (as on 31st December, 2025), for presenting their paper in the section of the Young Botanist Award. Applicant should submit soft copy of the full paper for this contest by 31st July, 2025 along-with other required information as per the given proforma, to The Secretary, Indian Botanical Society.

Applications submitted under this category shall be scrutinized by an expert committee. The best three selected papers shall be allowed for presentation during the conference for final selection. Each participant will be given 15 minutes time for paper presentation followed by discussion. The best presentation shall get Young Botanist Award 2025 (**Dr. Bahadur Singh Gold Medal**), of the Indian Botanical Society.

POSTER AWARD CONTEST: There shall be two medals for the best posters: (i) Prof. K.S. Bilgrami Gold Medal (author below the age of 35 years) and (ii) Prof. S.N. **Dixit Gold Medal** (author below the age of **50** years), as on 31st December 2025.

The restriction of age limit shall not apply to the Ph.D. supervisor, if he happens to be a co-author, but cannot be a participating contestant. Those willing to participate in the contest should identify/indicate the same while submitting the abstract and they must submit evidence of life membership and age proof. The life members should submit a soft copy of the manuscript for the contest by 31st July, 2025 to The Secretary, Indian **Botanical Society.**

PROF. Y.S. MURTY MEMORIAL GOLD MEDAL: A medal will be awarded to an outstanding plant morphologist/taxonomist up to the age of 50 years (as on 31st December 2025) for his/her research contributions in any group of plant kingdom. Contestants are required to send their detailed application as per given proforma providing list of publications and reprints of 10 best publications for evaluation by the expert committee constituted for the purpose. The life members should submit a soft copy of the application for this award to The Secretary, Indian Botanical Society by 31st July, 2025.

PROF. S.V.S. CHAUHAN GOLD MEDAL: A medal will be awarded to one of the youngest participants (from all the sections) up to the age of 25 years (as on 31st December, 2025) who has presented his/her research paper in any group of plant kingdom. Life members can submit their paper (single authorship) for this contest by 31st July, 2025 to the Organizing secretary.

MEDAL/AWARD FOR WOMEN SCIENTISTS

There is a Women Scientist Medal and a Woman Botanist Award for the Woman Scientists below the age of **50 years** (as on 31st December, 2025). An individual will receive only one award from either of the two in this category but can contest for the both.

- 1. **Woman Scientist Medal:** A medal for Woman Scientist up to the age of 50 years is instituted by the society to recognize lady botanists. Applications are invited as per the given proforma providing list of publications and reprints of 10 best papers published, for evaluation by the expert committee constituted for the purpose. The last date for submitting the soft copy of the application for the medal to **the Secretary of the Indian Botanical Society** is 31st July, 2025.
- 2. **Woman Botanist Award:** A separate section will be held for Woman Botanists below the age of 50 years for presenting their papers in the section of the Woman Botanist Award. Applicant should submit a **soft copy** of the full paper along with other required information as per the given proforma for this contest by **31**st **July, 2025** to The **Secretary, Indian Botanical Society**.

Applications submitted under this category shall be scrutinized by an expert committee, and **only three best selected papers** shall be allowed for presentation during the conference for final selection. Each participant will be given 18 minutes for paper presentation followed by the discussion. The best presentation shall get **Woman Botanist Award 2025** of the Indian Botanical Society.

- 3. **Prof. S.C. Dixit cash prize:** This award carries cash prize of Rs. 1000/- and is awarded for the best article published by a woman candidate (single author) in The Journal of Indian Botanical Society for the year *i.e.* published in 2024 (vol. 104).
- 4. IBS Active Participation Recognition Award:

There are Two separate awards which are instituted in 2023 by the members of the Executive Council of the Society to recognize "professional contribution and active participation" in All India Botanical Conference (AIBC), as well as to encourage young botanists for enhanced participation.

- **1. AIBC Champion**: for participation in at least **20 AIBC Conferences**.
- 2. AIBC Companion: for participation in at least 10 AIBC Conferences.

Applications / nominations are invited as per the given proforma. These shall be scrutinized by the expert committee constituted for the purpose. The last date of the receipt of the **soft**

copy of the application/ for this award to the Secretary, Indian Botanical Society is 30th June, 2025.

5. FELLOWSHIP OF THE INDIAN BOTANICAL SOCIETY (F.B.S.)

Life members who have completed at least five years of standing are eligible to apply for fellowship of the Society. Interested members are requested to send **only soft copy** of the application as per the given proforma for consideration by 31st July, 2025 to The Secretary, I.B.S. at <<u>secretaryibs2017@gmail.com</u>>. Applications submitted under this category shall be scrutinized by an expert committee.

The applicants, if found suitable shall be issued a Fellowship Certificate of F.B.S. on payment of requisite fee of Rs.1500/- during the conference only.
