Minutes of the meeting of the General Body of the XLVII All India Botanical Conference of the Indian Botanical Society held at CCS University, Meerut on 18th October 2024 at 3.30 pm.

Meeting of the GB of the Society was held at CCS University, Meerut, on 18th October 2024 at 3:30 PM under the Presidentship of Prof. U.C. Lavania

At the outset the President welcomed the members and asked the Secretary to take up the agenda.

The following items on the agenda were taken:

- To condole the death of members of society:
 Fortunately, no information of anyone leaving us during this year was reported.
- 2. Confirmation of minutes of last meeting held at SGB Amravati University, Amravati. (posted to the members on email on **Dec. 05, 2023**)
- **3.** The Secretary requested the Chief Editor of JIBS Prof. Y. Vimala to highlight the significant achievements and bottlenecks. Prof. Vimala Chief Editor, JIBS presented the Editor's report and stated that:
 - (i) Number of the articles received up to October 2024 are 157, carried forward from 2023 are 61, thus totaling 218; out of which 42 are published, 06 rejected. For 07 there was no response, and 163 are in process. The total income is Rs. 1,44,083/-; expenditure incurred was Rs 93000/-; and the balance in hand is Rs. 51,083-08/-; and bills pending are of Rs.65,225/-
 - (ii) The suggestion that the medal awardees should submit their lecture article in JIBS was reiterated.
 - (iii) The journal has been indexed in Web of Science. Prof. Trivedi asked about the status of online Newsletter. Responding, Prof. G.S. Shekhawat informed that the preparations are being done.

- (iv) All volumes of the Journal of the Indian Botanical Society are now available in digital form as scanned version, and have been uploaded on the Society's website.The journal is now Indexed in UGC-CARE, and listed in Web of Science.
- (v) The hard copies of all the issues are made available to the Library of CSIR-NBRI, Lucknow. To continue this arrangement the Society has entered into an MoU with the CSIR-NBRI Lucknow, to make them available any missing or future issues. As such the CSIR-NBRI, Lucknow shall be the Nodal Library for the JIBS.
- **4.** The Secretary requested the Treasurer of the Society Prof. Alok Kumar Srivastava to present the report for the financial year 2023-24.

Murty Memorial Lecture is to be organized at Kakatiya University by Dr. Lakshmana Reddy.

 - C. Prof. S.N. Chaturvedi Commemoration Lecture (2024): The name of Prof. V.P. Singh, Bareilly was proposed and accepted. As per the provisions, this Award Lecture is to be delivered at a place of choice decided by the Awardee.

D. IBS Foundation Lecture 2024:

It was proposed that the CSIR- NBRI may hold the IBS Foundation Lecture (2024) to be delivered by an eminent botanist. The name **Prof. Akhilesh K Tyagi**, University of Delhi (South Campus) was proposed and the same was accepted.

informed that the journal is now listed in **Web of Science**, as well.

Prof. Manoharachary suggested that the inactive and non responsive Editorial Board

members should be removed from the list. The Chief Editor was requested to rationalize

the Editorial Board for enhanced efficiency.
